The first challenge for West was to decide between opening 2 clubs or 1 heart. Clearly 2 clubs was the better bid with only 3 losers in hand. East then had to decide how to respond. I heard at one table

their response was 7 diamonds after partner opened 2 clubs. How simple bridge can be at times. Most pairs made much heavier weather of the bidding. One example of this was West opening 1 heart, East responding 2 diamonds, West deciding to show their hearts again bidding 3 hearts and East bidding 5 diamonds. Of the 15 tables, 2 found grand slam in diamonds, 5 found slam in diamonds, NT's and hearts and 8 tables only managed to find game on this beautiful hand.
